The **Magister Lycentinvs (ML)** of the University of Alicante is a **Legum Magister (LLM)** running its 17th edition in the 2010-2011 academic year. It started in 1994, the founding year of the agency responsible for registration of trademarks and designs of the European Union, the Office for Harmonisation in the Internal Market (**OHIM**).

After more than fifteen years of operation, the Magister Lycentinys has become one of the most prestigious and up-to-date European education centres on specialised subject-matters such as patents, trademarks, designs and copyright, which are fundamental for the development of the knowledge society. It is also an essential point of reference in both academic and professional circles dealing with intellectual property rights in Latin America.

Over the course of the academic year, students of the Magister Lycentinys study national, European and international Intellectual Property systems in highly orientated practical sessions (delivered in both Spanish and English). Leading academic and professional institutions across the world collaborate with the University of Alicante in delivering the course, including the OHIM, the European Patent Office (EPO), the World Intellectual Property Organisation (WIPO) and the Spanish Patents and Trademarks Office (OEPM). The academic faculty includes more than one hundred national and international lecturers, all of whom are well known specialists in their field.

The Magister Lycentinys also offers three University Specialist programmes and many courses and seminars, including the well-known Special Course on Community Trademarks, delivered completely in English by OHIM experts.

Each of the Specialist Programmes includes a large number of practical sessions based on the resolution of cases drawn from professional practice and led by experts in Intellectual Property Rights. Subject areas also cover technical vocabulary and terminology in English and French (the second optional language).

The **AAAML** (Association of Former Students of Magister Lycentinys) has more than three hundred associates and cooperates actively with the Magister, organising activities, guiding students and managing a **job exchange unit** that offers former students employment opportunities in the best Spanish and international companies, agencies and law firms. As a result, practically all of the Magister students find a satisfactory professional environment in a reasonable time.
